Brady graduated with a Juris Doctor from Michigan State University College of Law. Brady earned his undergraduate degree from Brigham Young University with a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science. He is married with five children and resides in Centerville, UT.

Jason Sterzer currently serves as the Director of the Division of Corporations and Commercial Code. Previously, he held positions within the Division of Securities as Securities Examiner and Securities Analyst.
